an affected version needs to be added to the issue upon creation only component leads can choose or add a fix version when the issue is transitioned to IN PROGRESS

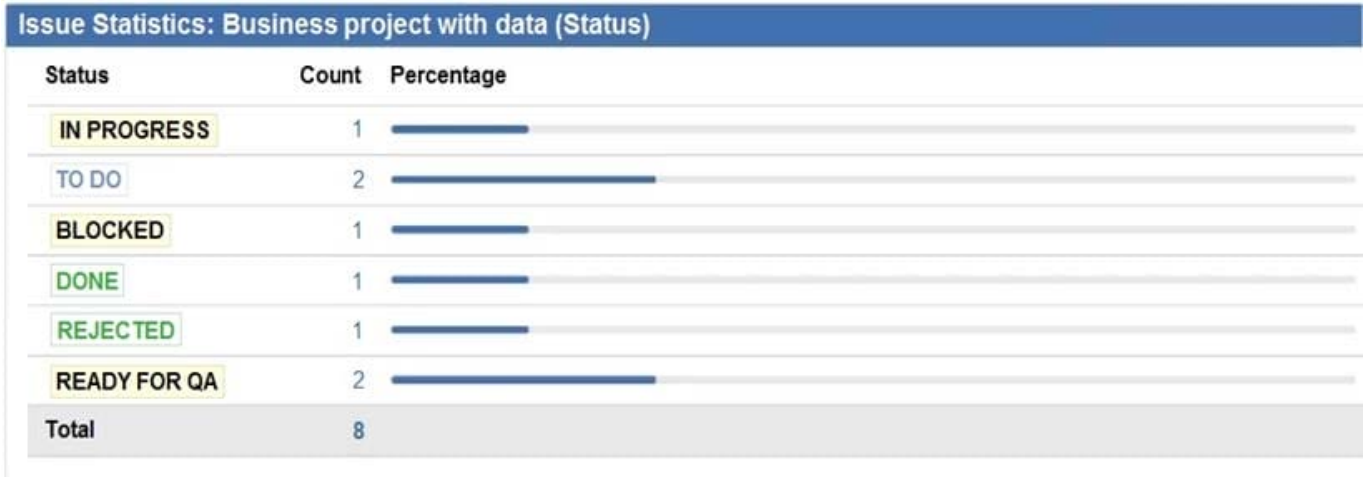
What two configurations are prerequisites to meet the requirements? (Choose two.)
