The rule created above is verified by using the command that follows:

```
::> vservers export-policy rule show
```

junction path /nfs01. A VMware export policy that allowed all the hosts of the cluster was applied to the SVM. However, the hosts are unable to mount the volume.

In this scenario, what caused the problem?
