Correct Answer: C
Hemoglobin bonds most strongly with carbon monoxide as a result of the interaction of the orbitals of the hemoglobin and the carbon monoxide molecule. The carbon forms an ionic bond with the hemoglobinl\'s iron, and because of the joint configuration, the iron is able to donate additional electrons to the carbon monoxide.

## QUESTION 3

Which hormone is released after a meal high in carbohydrates?
A. insulin
B. glucagon
C. EPO
D. ghrelin

Correct Answer: A
When the blood stream is over saturated with glucose (as a result of a meal high in carbohydrates), the pancreas releases insulin in order to regulate the glucose levels in the blood.
