Hadoop 2.0 Certification exam for Pig and Hive Developer

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QUESTION 1

On a cluster running MapReduce v1 (MRv1), a TaskTracker heartbeats into the JobTracker on your cluster, and alerts the JobTracker it has an open map task slot.

What determines how the JobTracker assigns each map task to a TaskTracker?

A. The amount of RAM installed on the TaskTracker node.

B. The amount of free disk space on the TaskTracker node.

C. The number and speed of CPU cores on the TaskTracker node.

D. The average system load on the TaskTracker node over the past fifteen (15) minutes.

E. The location of the InsputSplit to be processed in relation to the location of the node.

Correct Answer: E

Explanation: The TaskTrackers send out heartbeat messages to the JobTracker, usually every few minutes, to reassure the JobTracker that it is still alive. These message also inform the JobTracker of the number of available slots, so the JobTracker can stay up to date with where in the cluster work can be delegated. When the JobTracker tries to find somewhere to schedule a task within the MapReduce operations, it first looks for an empty slot on the same server that hosts the DataNode containing the data, and if not, it looks for an empty slot on a machine in the same rack.

Correct Answer: B

Explanation: Only one key value pair will be passed from the two (the, 1) key value pairs.

QUESTION 3

Given the following Pig command:

Which one of the following statements is true?

- A. The logevents relation represents the data from the my.log file, using a comma as the parsing delimiter

Correct Answer: B

QUESTION 4

Which one of the following statements is FALSE regarding the communication between DataNodes and a federation of NameNodes in Hadoop 2.0?

Correct Answer: D

From Cloudera Training Course: Task attempt is a particular instance of an attempt to execute a task ?There will be at least as many task attempts as there are tasks ?If a task attempt fails, another will be started by the JobTracker ?Speculative execution can also result in more task attempts than completed tasks

QUESTION 6

MapReduce v2 (MRv2/YARN) splits which major functions of the JobTracker into separate daemons? Select two.

- Correct Answer: BC

Explanation: The fundamental idea of MRv2 is to split up the two major functionalities of the JobTracker,

resource management and job scheduling/monitoring, into separate daemons. The idea is to have a global

ResourceManager (RM) and per-application ApplicationMaster (AM). An application is either a single job in

the classical sense of Map- Reduce jobs or a DAG of jobs.

Note:

The central goal of YARN is to clearly separate two things that are unfortunately smushed together in

current Hadoop, specifically in (mainly) JobTracker:

/ Monitoring the status of the cluster with respect to which nodes have which resources available. Under

YARN, this will be global.

/ Managing the parallelization execution of any specific job. Under YARN, this will be done separately for each job.

QUESTION 8

When can a reduce class also serve as a combiner without affecting the output of a MapReduce program?

B. When the signature of the reduce method matches the signature of the combine method.

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How many times will the Reducer\\'s reduce method be invoked?
A. 6

Correct Answer: B
Explanation: reduce() gets called once for each [key, (list of values)] pair. To explain, let\\'s say you called:
out.collect(new Text("Car"),new Text("Subaru");
out.collect(new Text("Car"),new Text("Honda");
out.collect(new Text("Car"),new Text("Ford");
out.collect(new Text("Truck"),new Text("Dodge");
out.collect(new Text("Truck"),new Text("Chevy");
Then reduce() would be called twice with the pairs reduce(Car,)
reduce(Truck,)

QUESTION 12

Indentify the utility that allows you to create and run MapReduce jobs with any executable or script as the mapper and/or the reducer?

- Correct Answer: D

Explanation: Hadoop streaming is a utility that comes with the Hadoop distribution. The utility allows you to create and run Map/Reduce jobs with any executable or script as the mapper and/or the reducer.

QUESTION 13

You want to count the number of occurrences for each unique word in the supplied input data. You\\'ve decided to implement this by having your mapper tokenize each word and emit a literal value 1, and then have your reducer increment a counter for each literal 1 it receives. After successful implementing this, it occurs to you that you could optimize this by specifying a combiner. Will you be able to reuse your existing Reduces as your combiner in this case and why or why not?

A. Yes, because the sum operation is both associative and commutative and the input and output types to the reduce method match.

B. No, because the sum operation in the reducer is incompatible with the operation of a Combiner.

C. No, because the Reducer and Combiner are separate interfaces.

D. No, because the Combiner is incompatible with a mapper which doesn\\'t use the same data type for both the key and value.



E. Yes, because Java is a polymorphic object-oriented language and thus reducer code can be reused as a combiner.

Correct Answer: A

Explanation: Combiners are used to increase the efficiency of a MapReduce program. They are used to aggregate intermediate map output locally on individual mapper outputs. Combiners can help you reduce the amount of data that needs to be transferred across to the reducers. You can use your reducer code as a combiner if the operation performed is commutative and associative. The execution of combiner is not guaranteed, Hadoop may or may not execute a combiner. Also, if required it may execute it more then 1 times. Therefore your MapReduce jobs should not depend on the combiners execution.
