Deploying cloud development environments

To deploy a cloud development environment in your LCS project:

Create a connection between an LCS project and your Azure subscription. You will need your Azure subscription ID and



authorize the use of the subscription.

Select + under Environments to deploy.

Select an application and platform version.

Select an environment topology. For more information, see Sign up for preview subscriptions.

If you chose a cloud-hosted environment, select which Azure connector you want to use. Then select Deploy.

Box 2: Azure DevOps

Azure DevOps provides developer services for allowing teams to plan work, collaborate on code development, and build and deploy applications. Azure DevOps supports a collaborative culture and set of processes that bring together

developers, project managers, and contributors to develop software.

Box 3: Git

Git is a DevOps tool used for source code management. It is a free and open-source version control system used to handle small to very large projects efficiently. Git is used to tracking changes in the source code, enabling multiple

developers to work together on non-linear development.





Box 1: Electronic reporting You can use Electronic reporting (ER) to format vendor checks. Many bank-specific and check provider ecific check formats are available on the market. Sample check formats have been included in the Payment check model in the ER tool repository. These sample checks are labeled Check in the middle (US) and Check on top stub below (US).

Box 2: Document management Business document management is built on top of the ER framework and enables business users to edit business document templates by using Microsoft 365 service or appropriate Microsoft Office desktop application. Edits to the documents might include changing business document designs and adding placeholders for additional data without source code changes and new deployments. No knowledge of the ER framework is required to update templates of business documents.

Box 1: Dual-write

When a work order is created, Dynamics 365 Field Service must create a sales order for that work order in real time.

Integrate Dynamics 365 Field Service and Supply Chain Management How it works

The integration is made possible because Field Service is built on top of Common Data Service and dual-write, which writes changes in Dynamics 365 Supply Chain Management to Common Data Service and vice versa.

Integration component



After dual-write is enabled, a solution is imported into Field Service that adds the required fields to make the entities in each system integratable.

Box 2: Business events

A user creates a change-based alert that will trigger when a newly created sales order from a workflow is greater than \$5,000. The alert must trigger a workflow the user can modify to automate other steps.

Business events provide a mechanism that lets external systems receive notifications from finance and operations applications. In this way, the systems can perform business actions in response to the business events.

Business events occur when a business process is run. During a business process, users who participate in it perform business actions to complete the tasks that make up the business process.

A business action that a user performs can be either a workflow action or a non-workflow action. Approval of a purchase requisition is an example of a workflow action, whereas confirmation of a purchase order is an example of a nonworkflow action. Both types of actions can generate business events that external systems can use in integration and notification scenarios.

Box 1: Non-functional

Requirements are commonly referred to as either functional or non-functional. Functional requirements describe what the solution needs to do or its behaviors, and non-functional requirements commonly describe non-behavior aspects of the

solution such as performance requirements.

The following examples are of well-composed non-functional requirements:

Average screen load time for internal users that are not mobile will be less than three seconds.

External portal must be able to handle 100 concurrent users who are performing case submission.

Any credit card number that is used cannot be stored in Common Data Service environment.

Box 2: Functional

Example functional requirements

The following scenarios describe simple examples of functional requirements:

As a sales user, I need to be able to close an opportunity as lost and then capture why it was lost so that we can improve our sales tactics in the future.

As a sales manager, I need to be able to approve a discount on a quote so that I can reduce the total price and give a discount to the customer.

As a staff accountant, I want to be prevented from closing a batch that has pending items so that I do not have to reopen it later.

Box 3: Non-functional

Examples of common non-functional requirement types include: Availability Compliance/regulatory * -> Data retention/residency Performance (response time, and so on) Privacy Recovery time Security Scalability

Box 1: Base, Finance, and Supply Chain Managemenet licences

Only the President/CEO, CFO, COO, Controller and VP Operations users must be able to access finance and warehouse features.
